





We expect that this decade will see substantial advances in the field of Virology. My own work in the area of virus-linked cancers, in particular HPV 16 and HPV 18 showed us the potential in this field. Thus, I would like to make a few remarks on the important stream topics of the conference.

Virology explores the nature of the viruses and their structure and assembly, viral genome replication and regulation of gene expression, genetic diversity and evolution, virus-cell interactions, cellular responses to infection, transformation and oncogenesis, gene delivery, viral pathogenesis and immunity, and vaccines and antiviral agents. OMICS: Knowledge dissemination through innovation

r. Srinubabu Gedela, a post doctorate de gree holder from Stanford University, initiated OMICS Educational Soci ety, which works on the model of acquiring already established schools by equipping them with the state of art technology and expertise. The group leverages its global experience, networks and contacts with scientific community in providing the best educational support to the schools it is acquiring or entering into a partnership.

"Indian universities in the past could attract stu-dents far and wide from across the continents. However, we are still lagging behind in areas of accessibility and affordability of quality education. According to the ministry of Central Statistics office, more than 90% of rural and urban households had a school with primary classes within 1 km in 2007-08. However, there are wide rural urban disparities in this regard as only 61.6% of rural households, compared to 82.5% of urban households, had a school within a km.

"We would like to plug-in gaps by connecting



the remote parts using technology" Dr. Srinubabu observed. According to him, OMICS Educational Society has already acquired Sri Satya Sai School and Junior College for Boys and Girls in Palakonda, located in the Srikakulam District of Andhra Pradesh. More than 5000 students have enrolled and 1200 students are pursuing various streams at the higher sec-ondary that follows the syllabus of Board of Intermediate Education, AP.

The society prepares educational tools such as text and reference books, apart from providing the study material in the audio-visual form. Constant faculty development training, refreshing sessions and exposure to latest interactive learning techniques like participation in workshops and seminars are a must" ex-plains Dr. Srinubabu.

Indian herbal drug industry must follow good manufacturing practices: Kokate



The Indian herbal drugs industry can boost its The Indian herbal drugs industry can boost its prospects if it adheres to global quality standards and follows good manufacturing practices, said Chandrakant Kokate, former president of the Pharmacy Council of India.

"If we want to make a mark in the international market, we need "If we want to make a mark in the international market, we need strict quality control, dinical validity, quality assurance and stability of our herbal products. Infact. the good manufacturing practice for herbal formulations that has been made mandatory several years ago is not being strictly implemented by the industry." Kotate said during the inaugural session of 'Pharmacognosy-2013' in Hyderabad on Monday.

Providing an insight into the global herbal drug industry, he said, around \$3,500 million worth of herbal medicines are produced annually and approximately 1,200 single ingredient and 10,500 polyherbal formulations are registered and used in the treatment of different diseases.

e industry faces a huge threat as the medicinal plants are disappearing fast.

"Hundreds of medicinal plants are at a risk of extinction, threatening the discovery of future diseases," S Mohan Jain from the University of Helsinki, Finland, said.

Importance of agriculture has undiminished over centuries

 Γ he chief task ahead is to bridge the gap between agriculture production achievable and achieved," said Dr Mohan Kanda, addressing a three-day international conference on Agriculture and Horticultural Sciences, at Hotel Radisson Blu, on Monday. Former chief secretary, Mohan Kanda was the chief guest of the function and noted scientists like Dr EA Siddiqi, honorary director, Biotechnology, of Institute Acharya NG Ranga Agricultural University (ANGRAU), Dr Alluri Padma Raju, vice-chancellor of ANGRU, Dr John Ryan and Dr Srinubabu Gedela, CEO, OMICS Group International, also addressed the conference. Mohan Kanda said that the importance of agriculture to any society and economy had stayed undiminished over centuries. "A strong agricultural sector is necessary for food and the nutritional security as also for employment and for the welfare and well-being of the very large population all over the world. The

challenges for agriculture and farming in the 21st century are to feed a growing population using sustainable farming methods," he added.

Dr EA Siddiq said, "India has made many technological advances in the field of agriculture since independence. These include Introduction of hybrid technology in maize and millets in mid 1950s, advent of semi-dwarf high yielding varieties of wheat and rice in mid 1960s, adoption of hybrid technology in rice since mid 1990s, introduction of exotic oilseed crops like sunflower and soybean and Hybrid technology in vegetable crops.

Giving the statistics by the end of the 20th century, Dr EA Siddiq said, "Over 240 million people remain malnourished, over 7000 die of hunger every day, about 60% women and children suffer from 'hidden hunger' (Protein malnutrition; Nutritional anaemia; low birth weight) and about 40 thousand children go blind every year due to vitamin A deficiency

What are the challenges to meet these demands? Visakhapatnam lad creates platform for access to research papers

VISAKHAPATNAM: Dr Srinu Babu Gadela has come a long way from a tiny village near Palkonda in Srikakulam district. The 31-year-old scientist, a product of Andhra University and Stanford, has created a platform, OMICS, which provides open access to research papers from various scientific fields to students and researchers from Third World countries.

"I hit upon the idea of an open platform, when I realized that I myself could not access certain kinds of literature required for my research work at Andhra University. The university just did not have these journals," observed Srinu Babu. Most researchers from developing countries are at a

disadvantage because many of the local universities do not possess the requisite literature in the After bagging the World Young Scientist-2007 award from the Human Proteome organization, libraries.

Srinu Babu formed the organization OMICS to allow people open access to research papers being published across the world.

"We have four centres across the globe, two in America (Los Angeles and Las Vegas), one in Romania and another in Hyderabad. As many as 750 people work there. These people liaison with various research organisations, universities and individual scientists to ensure that their papers are published on the OMICS site," said Babu. There is a team of more than 30,000 editorial board members, the world over, whose main job is to edit the papers as freelancers.

Today OMICS boasts of a readership base of 5 million and has so far published over 3 lakh papers from various fields of science.

"The origins of OMICS were rather humble. I started my own journal called the Proteomics-Bioinfomatics around 2006 and published roughly about 50 articles both my own and those of others. All this was done with the help of Stanford University, the Human Proteome Organization. Today OMICS has more than 350 journals of its own," Babu said.

Babu himself has published close to 50 papers in the field of Bioinfomatics and takes pride in the fact that apart from papers on science, mathematics, technology and applications, they also have started journals to publish papers in the fields of management.

The group also conducts close to a 100 seminars every year across the globe.




Proceedings of OMICS Group Conferences


Country wise Attendance to OMICS Group Conferences
