Global deaths of new born babies remain alarmingly high, particularly among the world's poorest countries. Babies born in Japan, Iceland and Singapore have the best chance at survival, while new borns in Pakistan, the

Central African Republic and Afghanistan face the worst odds. Globally, in low-income countries, the average new born mortality rate is 27 deaths per 1,000 births, the report says. In high-income countries, that rate is 3 deaths per 1,000. New born from the riskiest places to give birth are up to 50 times more likely to die than those from the safest places.
